



**Response of SiamAI
to Bloomberg News Report of May 8, 2026**

SiamAI is aware of recent press reports attempting to link the Company to certain shipping conduct that forms the basis of an U.S. federal indictment pending in the Southern District of New York involving several individuals formerly affiliated with Super Micro Computer, Inc. (SMCI).

To be clear, SiamAI has not engaged in the export of AI servers to China. Siam AI is willing to cooperate in good faith with any inquiries or investigations conducted by the U.S. government. Further, Siam AI is committed to full adherence to all applicable U.S. export and re-export control laws and regulations.

SiamAI will not make any statements on behalf of OBON, but does note, as a correction to recent press reports, that SiamAI maintains independent headquarters and does not share an office with OBON.

SiamAI is a Bangkok based-artificial intelligence (AI) cloud provider that is dedicated to providing high-performance computing resources specifically for AI workloads throughout Thailand. Siam AI positions itself as a strategic custodian of AI sovereignty, advancing the principle that Thailand should retain ownership and control over its AI infrastructure, data, and core technological capabilities. Among its core projects are the development of SiamGPT, a localized large language model (LLM) designed to comprehend Thai language, legal context, culture, and societal nuances with greater precision than generalized global models. Additionally, SiamAI acts as a strategic business-to-business (“B2B”) and business-to-government (“B2G”) partner to integrate AI into Thailand’s critical infrastructure. Siam AI also extends its AI infrastructure and technical capabilities to support education, medical research, and public sector innovation in Thailand, reflecting a commitment to generating societal value throughout Thailand.
